Changes coming...

The Moose International mobile app that includes the new electronic membership card was developed to keep current with the technology trends expected by individuals who rely on their phones to conduct day-to-day business. The app allows members to access their individual Moose record, sign new members, pay dues, locate lodges, and more.

The Moose mobile app, available on the Apple Store and Google Play, may be downloaded and used with your current card. Beginning May 1, 2023, all printed membership cards will be produced with QR codes instead of a magnetic stripe. Life members and those that have paid dues years in advance will continue to use their current cards and will not be issued new cards, however, they are encouraged to download the new app and have access to an electronic card. The electronic card is nearly identical to the current card graphically and the expiration date is in the same location.

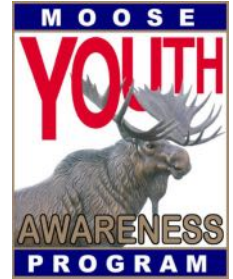
